### Assessing Needs:

- Child and youth observations
- Parent / caregiver interviews
- Functional Behavior Assessment (FBA)

### Setting Individualized Programming Goals:

- Decrease High-Risk Behaviors
- Increase Independence
- Increase Social Skills
- Build Communication Skills
- Strengthen Family Relationships

### Providing Parent / Caregiver Training:

- Scheduled parent education sessions
- Demonstrate / model procedures
- Hands-on practice and feedback
- Work as a team to evaluate effectiveness, problem solve and address behavior challenges
